

## Guidelines for Red Light/Green Light

In order to promote a more enriching and loving sharing of fellowship at the Red Light/Green Light sessions North Florida Area suggest the following:

### Selection Process

Group Representatives ask their groups for topics and bring them to the District meeting. At the District meeting, GR's vote on one topic. District Representatives bring one topic to the Area World Service Committee meeting. Those topics are turned into the North Florida Area Chairperson during the morning session on Saturday. Before the close of session on Saturday, the Alternate Delegate and the chairperson for the next Red Light/ Green Light session will go over the topics. They will ensure that topics are not repeated during our Panel and then choose 6 topics.

At the AWSC, volunteers are asked to take a topic home, research it, and present it at the Red Light/Green Light meeting at the Assembly.

Those topics will be published in the next issue of The Legacy and posted on the North Florida web-site. As well as distributed by the DR's to their GR's prior to Assembly.

After Assembly, research data (not opinions) can be published in the following issue of The Legacy and posted on the North Florida web-site.

### Session Process

1. We ask that everyone attending the session review the topics and choose one or two as their personal priority choices and limit their sharing to them. In this way everyone will have an opportunity to share and no one person will monopolize.
2. Sharings will be limited to 2 minutes. A red stop sign will go up and the next person can proceed to the mike. A timer will assist.
3. We ask that if what you have to share has already been said, that you choose another topic.
4. Because no topic is more or less important than another, each will be limited to no more than 10 minutes.
5. The member that researched the topic will be the first to share keeping their sharing to a maximum of 5 minutes.
6. We ask that everyone come to the mike to share.
7. We ask that Tradition 10 and Concept 4 be our guide "principles above personalities".
8. We ask that when you enter or leave the room you do so quietly. Please respect one another by your silence during sharing.
