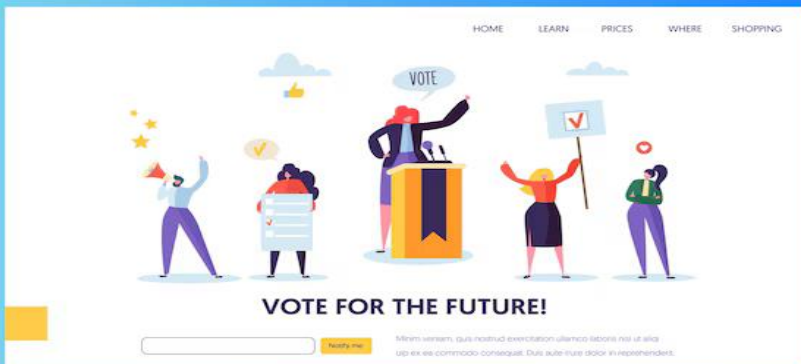

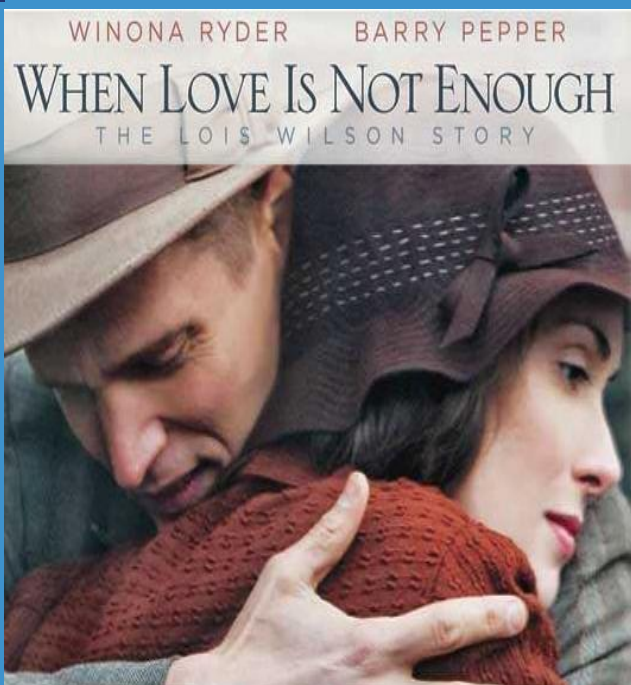


PORT LINCOLN FILM AND FELLOWSHIP FUNDRAISER
