ELECTION ASSEMBLY



It's Election year for the Al-Anon SA Area!!

As part of a three-year rotation, there will be an election assembly on Sunday 16th November in the SA Al-Anon offices, Level 2, 25 Leigh St, Adelaide.

At the election assembly, current service members will be stepping down from their positions on the [SA Area Service Committee](#) and [Association Committee](#) as their terms of office are now complete. Some may decide to take on another term of service in their current role, but all service positions on the Committees and for [Group Reps](#) and [District Reps](#) will be declared vacant and new ones need to be elected. Committee members will begin their three-year period of service from 1st January 2026.

Each group needs to elect a new Group Rep prior to the Election Assembly, as the Group Reps must vote on behalf of their Groups to fill the incoming service positions. This is why it is so important that each Group is represented at the Assembly by a Group Rep. If your Group does not have one, it is most important that the Group elect a member to represent them at the Assembly. There is only one vote per Group, so you need to have your say! N.B. Only Group members can vote for their GR and only the GRs within the 3 Districts are able to vote for the District Rep in their District.

Service Positions are 3-year terms and are a vital part of Al-Anon as a whole, and for your personal recovery. Please consider offering to take on one of the many and varied roles that need to be filled. For detailed position statements click this here: [SA Position Descriptions](#)

Alateen Coordinator – If you have a heart for helping children affected by someone's else's drinking this role might be for you.

Archives Coordinator – This role would suit you if you love history as it involves preserving Al-Anon SA history through records from Groups, and special events.

Membership Services/Technology Support – This is a newer position and would be interesting for those among us who love to work with technology eg. recently we investigated an alternative to using ZOOM for committee meetings. You also check that the website information for SA is accurate and arrange for any changes needed.

Literature Coordinator - Love to read Al-Anon Literature? If this is you, as Literature Coordinator you hear first about the new CAL being produced and let members know. It also involves ordering CAL for members and Groups.

Newsletter Coordinator – This role involves putting together the monthly newsletter using input from members about what is happening in Al-Anon in SA, including anniversaries, fundraising etc. Newsletters are mainly distributed online. Training is available to support this.

Public Information Coordinator – This role coordinates a team of helpers, to connect with the community and professionals about Al-Anon. If you have the time, this role will suit you. There is lots of information prepared by the national office to help – the website, poster, speakers for events etc.

Special Functions Coordinator – This is an important role for Al-Anon SA as it involves organising the Groups to participate in the annual Spring Fair - our major fundraiser for the year. Other events are arranged throughout the year such as the picnic at Semaphore. If you have ideas for events to bring members from across Adelaide together for fun and fellowship, then this role might be for you.

Office Coordinator – This role is making sure that the membership has access to information needed to run their meetings through the CAL sold in the office, information about our insurances, the Guidelines (also available online), and often being the first point of contact with people suffering the effects of another's drinking. This includes organizing the office hours and after-hours phone.

Group Representative and District Representative – These positions are part of the SA Area Service Committee. There are detailed position descriptions for these roles. **The Al-Anon Service Handbook** is an excellent resource that explains how Group Reps and District Reps link to Al-Anon as a whole and what service involves.
