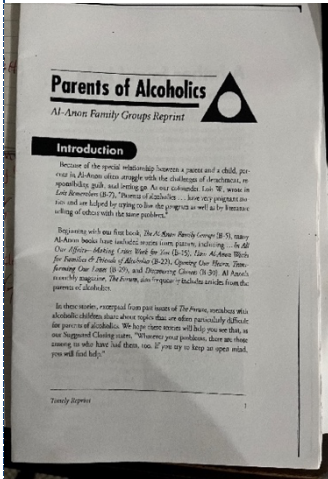

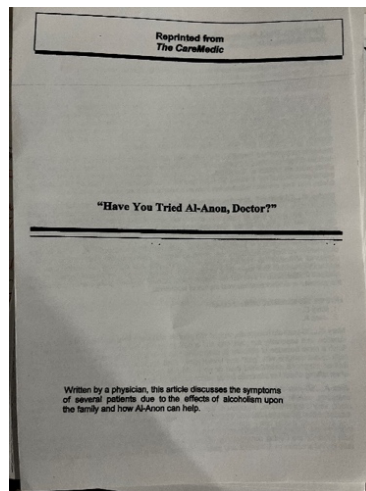
What CAL have you never really explored?

At the Assembly this year, as Literature Coordinator, I brought a motley box of CAL for sale that is rarely ordered or used in meetings. I was hoping to introduce members to some of the incredible resources we have. It was encouraging when many publications were bought by members who expressed surprise and delight at finding things they had not known about. So, in the same vein, some of our more obscure CAL will be explored in coming months in the Northern Light.



To begin...there are several small leaflet publications listed at the very bottom of the order sheet as "Forum Reprints" including "Living with a Timebomb", "Parents of Alcoholics" (right), "Have you Tried Al-Anon, Doctor?" (below), "Al-Anon and Counseling", and "Domestic Violence", to name a few. One district routinely uses some of these as PI material when they are doing PI work at venues like "White Ribbon Day" and Homeless Connect Days. They are incredibly powerful pieces of insight about the program and it's effectiveness and could well be used in Newcomer's Packs or when newcomers have a particular need to identify.

The one directed at doctors lists various physical manifestations of anxiety displayed by those affected by another's drinking that might alert a GP to what the underlying case of that anxiety could be. It also beautifully shows that doctors themselves need to set boundaries.
