

\*A picture of Mavis L., the founding member of Al-Anon in Victoria. Her group started in Ballarat.

\*A book, *The Al-Anon Family Groups: a guide for the families of problem drinkers*, was sent to this group on May 24, 1957 from the Al-Anon HQ in New York and inscribed:

*With all good wishes*

*To you all over there*

*From us over here, Lois*

(Lois is, of course, Lois W., the Co-founder of the original Al-Anon.)

\*A picture of the shop at 105 Collins Street, where the first meeting was held in the Melbourne CBD.

\*There is a large, framed photo with a picture of every VSA Delegate since 1977. It has 16 spots for photos and this week we filled in the last spot! Now we need to start a new frame with our current Delegate, Nerise D., being the next Delegate in the line stretching into the future.

On 13<sup>th</sup> September this year, in the Ross Town Hall, there will be a celebration of 65 years of Al-Anon in Tasmania. Their chosen theme is 'An Attitude of Gratitude'. By recording our history, we show our gratitude to all those members who have ensured the continuity of Al-Anon and guard the program for the benefit of us all.




